ATHLETIC EVENT SUPERVISION

REMINDERS

Please be reminded that the **FRONT PARKING LOT IN THE MORNING** is only for parking, **NOT for unloading.** If you would like to park and walk your student into his classroom, you may use the back portion of the front parking lot. Otherwise, please use the morning car line drop-off in the back parking lot.



For morning car line, please allow the aides to help your student out of the car instead of getting out of the driver's seat to do so as this slows down the line.

For afternoon car line, students should only be entering the vehicle on the passenger side. It is dangerous for students to be walking around the back or front side of the vehicle in order to enter the vehicle on the driver's side. If you need to take time to buckle your student into their seat, please pull over to the side parking lot near the church to do so.
